REFRAIN FROM PARKING IN THE FIRE LANES



On a small table in my bedroom rests a frame that contains three words: Remain In Me.

These three words remind me daily of the importance of staying close to Jesus; to remain in His love. Over the course of a day, there are numerous ways we can allow ourselves to get pulled away from intimacy with Christ.

Serious sin sits at the top of the list. When we choose to sin, we distance ourselves from the Lord. God does not withdraw from us. We withdraw from God. We lose grace. This is spiritual physics. The sacrament of reconciliation, in the wake of serious sin, can restore grace.

Jesus reminds us in today's Gospel, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments."

Loving parents establish "rules" for their children. Why? Well, ideally, for the good of the child. A child can't always see what mom and dad can see. Mom reminds Johnny not to touch the hot stove because she loves him and does not want his fingers to get burned.

God also desires the good of His children. Of course, we are free to rebel, act out, and disobey. The Lord has given us "rules" that are not arbitrary, but for the good of humanity (individually and collectively).

The wisdom of years helps us wake up and say, "Maybe God knows a little something about us as human beings."

The greatest gift God has given us is the Holy Spirit. You received the Holy Spirit at your baptism and the fullness of the Spirit in Confirmation. This Spirit helps us in so many ways, but especially in helping guide us in love and truth.

In our spiritual lives, we must also be aware that there is a countering spirit that seeks to pull us out of relationship with God and one another. This is the spirit that seduces us to sing, "I did it my way." This spirit seeks to blind us toward God's love and truth. It wants us to rebel, to act out, and to disobey. Far too many folks today have given their ear and heart to this persuasive voice.

Fortunately, we have a Good Shepherd, who knows our name and desires to protect us. We do well to heed His voice; to follow His commands. Not because He is a loveless tyrant, but because, like a concerned sleepless loving mom, He waits up for us to come Home.

My mom was wonderful. Yes, she

had flaws and quirks, but I never doubted her love and care for me. I'm pretty sure she had concerns during my wayward years. I'm also sure her prayers played a major part in my re-version to faith and to my calling to the priesthood.

My mom died suddenly of a heart attack at age 78 back in 2007. I found her lifeless body on the floor of her kitchen. I gave the eulogy at her funeral. Looking back, I can now see that was one of the first prompts toward rediscovering my vocation. Thanks, mom! You were the most Irish loving Bohemian/ Polish woman I knew.

I do realize not everyone has or had a good mother. There are some tough stories out there, and for this, I am sorry.

We only have one mother. This is the woman who literally gave birth to us. She endured the pains of labor, and delivered us into this world. Ideally, the nurturing of life started on day one and continues beyond death in our hearts and memories.

Thus, today we wish all mothers a Happy Mother's Day.

Please pray for all mothers and for those who so eagerly desire to become one. Remember, there was a time when your mom held your tiny little new-born body in her arms. She is your mom, and you will always be her child.
