# FR. BOB'S WEEKLY BLOG

One of the shortest but most powerful prayers is “Veni, Sancte Spiritus.”

Translated from the Latin into English this means “Come, Holy Spirit.” In any given moment, whether it be a moment of decision-making, a trial or a temptation, we can all recite this prayer asking that the Holy Spirit guide us, counsel us, strengthen us.

Sadly, we sometimes forget to involve the Holy Spirit. On this the Solemnity of Pentecost, we are being reminded of the great gift we have received via our Baptism and our Confirmation. Nothing sacred happens without the work of the Holy Spirit. We need the Holy Spirit. The Church needs the Holy Spirit. Our parish needs the Holy Spirit. Each one of us needs the Holy Spirit. We suffer spiritually when we try to go it alone merely on human power.

Ponder the following quote from Reinhard Bonke:

“The less Holy Spirit we have, the more cake and coffee we need to keep the church going. Nothing against cake or coffee but there is no substitute for the Holy Spirit.”

The danger in church life comes when we start to prefer cake and coffee over the Holy Spirit. Losing sight of the Holy Spirit can have a corrosive effect; whether in our personal life or in the communal life of the church, which includes parish life.

Christ gives us the Eucharist to help center parish life on God. At every Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, Ordinary bread and wine become – by the POWER of

the Holy Spirit – the Body and Blood of Jesus. We call the Eucharist COMMUNION for a reason. We are drawn closer to God and closer to one another as brothers and sisters in Christ.

In the spiritual life, we also face the reality of others spirits that are not at all loving or truthful. These nefarious spirits seek to distance us from God and from one another. The enemy spirits seek to create discord in the body of Christ. When we cooperate with these spirits, soon we find ourselves viewing a fellow Christian as a “them.” The Enemy succeeds in manifesting the four D’s of the diabolic: division, deceit, discouragement, and diversion.

The Holy Spirit helps us re-focus on union with Christ and union with each other within the Mystical Body of Christ, which is the Church.

Come, Holy Spirit. Place into our hearts a spirit of union with Christ so that our hearts are surrendered to the crucified and risen Lord. This helps us grow together in authentic love; a love that wills the good of the other, as other. This kind of love transforms hearts, which can then transform the world, the Church, our parish, and our families.

We certainly want to congratulate the children graduating from our parish school (St. Symphorosa School). We pray for them as they enter the summer months before embarking on a new chapter of their respective lives in high school.

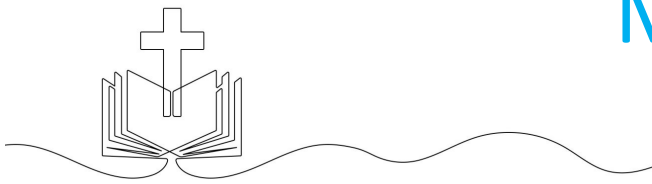
This group is also responsible for taking care of flowers/plants and working out a watering schedule.

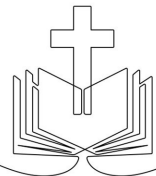

## Why Are There Liturgical Cycles?

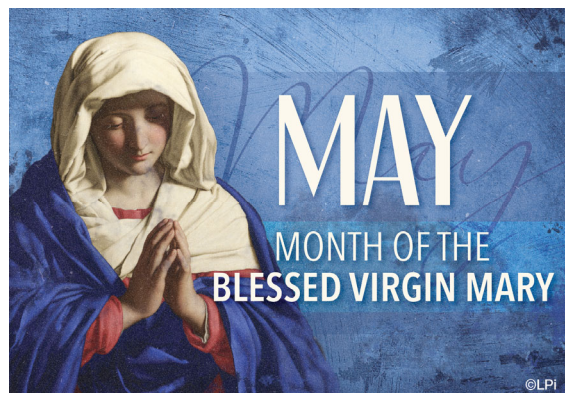
**Question: Why Does the Church Have Different Liturgical Cycles?**

**Answer:**

While most Catholics know that the Church Year is divided into various seasons (e.g. Advent, Christmas, Ordinary Time, etc.), many are unaware that the one Church Year is not like the one that follows. While the main seasons and feasts are the same from year to year, the 3-year cycle for Sundays and the 2-year cycle for weekdays means that, as a general rule, the readings in the *Lectionary* that we hear at Mass will change from year to year, helping us to have a richer encounter with Sacred Scripture. Each new cycle begins with the beginning of the liturgical year, the First Sunday of Advent.

The reasoning behind this innovation is outlined in *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, the "Dogmatic Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy" of the Second Vatican Council: "The treasures of the bible are to be opened up more lavishly, so that richer fare may be provided for the faithful at the table of God's word. In this way a more representative portion of the holy scriptures will be read to the people in the course of a prescribed number of years" (no. 51). This was fully achieved in 1969 when the new cycles of readings were approved by Pope Saint Paul VI.
