God exists. God does not exist.

Well, which one is true? Both statements about God cannot be true. God is, or God is not.

We can easily dismiss the question of God as no big deal, but it matters a lot. There are many people today who believe in the reality of God, and there are plenty of people who do not believe in the reality of God. Is everyone correct?

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is an invitation for each of us to ponder the reality of God; Who God is.

Thanks be to revelation, we know that God is One, but in that Oneness of God is a Trinity of three Divine Persons: God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit. As Catholics we are not polytheists. We do not believe there are three Gods. We are monotheists, but Christ has revealed to us a divine relationship of love within the one Godhead.

We can try our best to bring this great Trinitarian mystery down to human language. Think of God the Father as Lover, God the Son as the beloved, and God the Holy Spirit as the Love between the Father and the Son. When we use the word love, it pretty much assumes an other. Love in isolation doesn't make much sense.

Let's imagine for a moment a world without love. Would this be a good place for human beings to flourish? I think not. Well, God is love. And if we push God out of the picture (as if that were possible), then we'd be pushing love out of the picture. The world would become a very lonely, fearful, scary place without God; without love.

Let's recall this weekend the wonderful definition of love given to us by St. Thomas Aquinas. He wrote, "Love is willing the good of the other, as other." Love is never selfish. Love is not permissive. When we love with an authentic love, then we want what is best for every human being.

A loving parent who expresses concern about a child's destructive behavior is not "hating" on the child. If the child has gotten lost in drugs, alcohol, or pornography, then the parents are showing loving concern for the child's well-being.

God the Father has the same loving concern for creation and for His children. That's the essence of our Gospel message this Sunday. God the Father has sent God the Son in the Person of Jesus, the Christ. He is the long-awaited Messiah who comes not to live on earth but to die on earth so that you and I might have eternal life.

Occasionally we see on the news a Missing Person story. A child has gone missing. Mom and dad – along with relatives and friends – begin a day-and-night search for the beloved. No one will rest until the child is safely home.

This is God's love for us. Sometimes we go missing. This can look a few different ways. We can go missing by engaging in serious sin and not seeking reconciliation in Confession. We can also go missing from our participating in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. The family has gathered on Sunday and some of our brothers and sisters are not with us.

We can also go missing by way of sloth. What is sloth? Basically, sloth is spiritual laziness. We become indifferent to the things of God; to sacred things. We don't pray. We don't engage in the sacraments (especially the Eucharist). We don't read and reflect on sacred scripture. We don't practice the corporeal works of mercy nor the spiritual works of mercy. Pretty soon, we don't even care. And that is spiritually lethal for us as individuals and as a society.

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but

might have eternal life." (John 3:16).

We are never "too busy," to live out our faith. If we are too busy, then something has gone very wrong. We've made something else or someone else God who is NOT God. We can all become susceptible to sloth, at times. We can forget how important the spiritual life is for us as human beings. Are you too busy to pray? Are you too busy to participate in Sunday Mass? Who or what has become your object of worship?

Some folks might think we'd all be better off without God, and certainly without religion. I strongly disagree. But we must remember, it has not been us in search of God. It has been God in search of us. He sent His Son on a divine rescue mission to bring us back into relationship, and finally, to bring us Home.

Authentic religion seeks to connect divinity and humanity; heaven and earth. Do human beings mis-use and corrupt religion? Yup! Sadly, it's true. But that cannot be our excuse to turn our backs on the avenue God has given us to receive His grace and to live a life of grace. We do so in and through the Church.

Who are our models along the way? Jesus. Mary. The saints. The Lord has given us the Holy Spirit as a Guide, a Counselor, a Comforter, an Advocate. We are NEVER alone on this journey Home. We may go missing on occasion, but we know the Father has left a light on in the Person of His Son.

Praise the Holy Trinity!

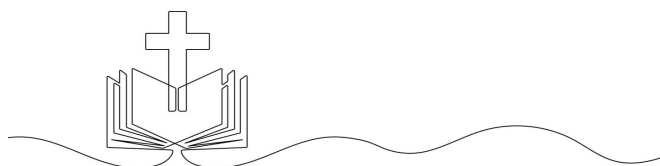

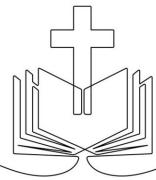

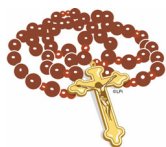
